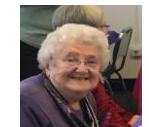
SDAY, MAY 7 AT 10:00 The Irish came over first, about 2 million during the Great Hunger, 1845-49. They were the gatekeepers for such trades as: building, police force, fire dept, and at length, politics. The Italians came later; arriving at the turn of the 20th century. At first they were the bitterest of enemies; the Italians imbued with a devotion dedicated to their saints, the Irish equally devout but murmuring their Hail Mary's in quietude. Things changed through intermarriage beginning in post WWII New York. We will look into some of the high points and the low points of the evolution, from Garibaldi's surprise arrival on Staten Island to Andrew Cuomo's duel over infanticide legislation with Timothy Cardinal Dolan. Balance and Stability have somewhat similar meanings, they cannot be used interchangeably. There is a distinctive difference between balance and stability, especially in terms of body movements. When we are talking about the movements of the body, balance refers to the ability to maintain the control of the body in a still position whereas stability refers to the ability to maintain the control of the body while in motion.
