Safe Seniors Contact Program Request Form

The Easton Police Department in conjunction with the Easton Senior Center invites you to become part of our Safe Seniors Contact Program which replaces the automated Are You Ok (RUOK) Program.

The Safe Seniors Contact Program is a free service available to any resident of Easton over 60 or any resident who is homebound, medically disabled or resides alone. Each day a phone call is placed to the individual's residence by a trained volunteer at 9:00 am or 2:00 pm (see below for time choice to be called). If there is no answer after two attempts a police officer is dispatched to the residence to check on the well being of the subscriber. If you will not be home for any reason on any day please notify the Senior Center in advance (a message may be left on the Senior Center voice mail (203)268-1145. Messages are checked daily) to avoid a Police Officer being dispatched to your home.
